The following Report of result of a Precognition has been received, touching the death of *Michael Mullen*, Registered under Entry No. *957* in the Register Book of Deaths for the year 1907:—

<i>Michael Mullen,</i> <i>37 years.</i> <i>Male.</i>	<i>29th July, 1907.</i> <i>1.45 a.m. Royal Infirmary,</i> <i>Glasgow (res. 100 Easterhill Street,</i> <i>Tollcross.</i>	<i>From injuries sustained by</i> <i>deceased on 23rd July, 1907 -</i> <i>that he was severely burned</i> <i>while alone in the pit &</i> <i>according to his own state-</i> <i>ment his injuries were due</i> <i>to an explosion of his safety</i> <i>lamp, but that the jury are</i> <i>unable to say whether this</i> <i>was the case or whether an</i> <i>explosion was due to the use</i> <i>of a naked light in the presence</i> <i>of gas, per verdict of jury.</i>
